Dubois-Pike Federal Credit Union is once again offering a \$1000 scholarship to one eligible senior in each of the Dubois and Pike County high schools.

Qualifications:

The student must be a senior in high school and an active member of Dubois-Pike Federal Credit Union.

All high school students are eligible to open an account with the credit union with a \$5.00 deposit.

How do I enter for the scholarship?

Fill out the Common Scholarship Application that is available in the guidance counselor's office at all the schools and turn it in by April 1, 2026. Also, attach your transcript, a short essay about yourself, and at least one letter of recommendation.
